Additional Requirements:

I certify that my business is adhering to all governmental rules, regulations and requirements in operation of my business, including but not limited to those rules established by the County Department of Environmental Health, County Department of Public Health, and the State Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control for both ongoing operations.

I understand that the City's acceptance of this encroachment permit application does not constitute approval be the City. Furthermore, I understand that any person who does or causes to be done any improvement or encroachment work of any kind within the City's right-of-way without first having obtained a permit therefore, is in violation of Municipal Code Section 12.08.040 and therefore deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six months, or by both fine and imprisonment, per Municipal Code Section 12.08.150.

Applicant agrees to provide the City required documentation for tent structure calculations, fire resistance certifications, vendor permission to use heaters, acknowledges that temporary tent structure(s) and heating device(s) will meet local and state codes, and will obtain necessary insurance and hold the City of Morgan Hill harmless in the event of a structure failure.

Applicant agrees to provide the City with a \$1,000 refundable security deposit upon City's acceptance of the encroachment permit, if the proposed parklet will be operated in the public right-of-way. The security deposit will be returned to the applicant upon full deconstruction of the parklet or the transfer of the parklet to a new operator as determined by City issuance of a new encroachment permit to the new operator. Applicant agrees to pay the City a \$1,000 annual rental fee, for use of city tree light electrical access, for the purpose of providing mandatory lighting for safety and visibility. The annual rental fee will go into effect January 1, 2023 and will continue each year until full parklet deconstruction is completed or the parklet is transferred to a new operator by way of City issuance of a new encroachment permit.

I agree Initials ____

Applicant agrees to provide the City with access to City infrastructure if the proposed parklet will be operated in the public right-of-way. If deconstruction of the parklet is required to obtain City access, the applicant will deconstruct the parklet at their own cost. Failure to maintain the cleanliness, safety, and accessibility of a parklet properly and sufficiently may be subject to violations and fines. If maintenance issues are not resolved, parklet operators may be required to remove the parklet at their own expense.

space or parklet shall begin until an encroachment permit is issued.
